Application to Create a Scareorama

What is a Scareorama? A small room or open area within Haunted High that is designed and built by a specific group, i.e. OHS club, Oconomowoc service club, area business. The group provides the idea, materials and labor.

The best scenes will have the following characteristics:

- very scary, bone-chilling, startling, etc.
- somewhat thematic to an old, spooky “high school”
- some relationship to the purpose/mission of the sponsoring group
 - o signage to promote the group is allowed/encouraged
- no guns or overt depiction of the act of violence
- no depictions of sex, drugs, alcohol, etc.
- on site building can be done in a day or so
- do not require staffing to be scary
 - o note: live actors within a Scareorama are allowed but beware that there are over 45 “open” hours that would need to be staffed

Current in-building work periods for groups approved to do a Scareorama are September 24 – 27 and October 3 – 4 (final touches). Please check www.hauntedhigh.info/COE.html for updates; please advise when the group will be there.
